STEP 1: PLEASE CLICK THE HYPERLINK ON EACH FORM

CAN-2: DECLARATION OF CANDIDACY FOR PRIMARY NOMINATION IN 2026

- → This form is for selecting the office you are running for
- → Fill out all fields and any boxes that apply
- → The "Candidate Name Information" section is how you would like your name to appear on the ballot. (Read fine print for requirements)
- → On the second page, initial all lines that apply to you, sign, date and provide a phone number
- → The second page must be signed in person with a notary or at the time of filing
- → File in person at the Clerk's office

CAN-12: STATEMENT OF ECONOMIC INTERESTS FOR LOCAL AND SCHOOL BOARD OFFICES

- → Fill out all fields and any boxes that apply
- → This is for the calendar year before the date of this filing
- → If the questions do not apply, put N/A
- → The second page must be signed in person with a notary or at the time of filing
- → File in person at the Clerk's office

<u>CFA-1: CANDIDATE'S STATEMENT OF ORGANIZATION AND DESIGNATION OF PRINCIPAL COMMITTEE OR EXPLORATORY COMMITTEE.</u>

- → If the office you seek makes *more* than \$5,000/year and you receive or spend \$100.00 you <u>MUST</u> fill out this form to create a committee
- → If the office you seek makes <u>less</u> than \$5,000/year and you receive or spend \$500.00 you <u>MUST</u> fill this form to create a committee
- → May be turned in at the time of filing <u>but MUST be turned in by NOON, 10 days after</u> a committee is created
- **→ STEP 2:**

CFA-4: REPORT OF RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURES OF A POLITICAL COMMITTEE

- → If you filed a CFA-1 report you will use this form to report your contributions and expenditures for your committee.
- → See the calendar for filing dates!! Do not be late, penalties will apply!!
- → A *printed copy* of the CFA-4 report will need to be submitted for the *Pre-Primary*, the *Pre-Election* and the *Annual* report, *unless* you *disband* your committee with the Election Board.
